## The Nick P. Bada Award for Excellence In Project Management 2014 Application Information and Guidelines



The Nick P. Bada Award for Excellence in Project Management was established in recognition of Nick Bada's outstanding contribution to The Chang School as an instructor in the Project Management certificate program.

#### Information

#### **Purpose**

The Award will provide financial assistance and recognize the academic achievement of an exceptional Chang School certificate student in the Project Management certificate program who has completed the five core Project Management courses and has maintained a minimum cumulative (GPA) of 3.33 B<sub>+</sub>.

#### Value

There is one (1) annual award valued at \$1,000.00.

#### Eligibility

To be eligible for this award the student must:

- Be officially enrolled as a certificate student in the Project Management Certificate program and have completed the five core Project Management certificate courses:
  - CKPM 202 Fundamentals of Project Management
  - CKPM 203 Planning and Scheduling
  - CKPM 209 Project Risk and Quality Management
  - CKPM 211 Leadership in Project Management
  - CKPM 212 Project Cost and Procurement Management.
- Applicants must submit a letter of no more than 350 words indicating how this award will contribute to his/her continued success in the field and application of Project Management.
- Applicants must be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident.
- Applicants must be an Ontario resident (12 consecutive months).

Note: Students who have received the award may not reapply.

#### **Selection Criteria**

Applicants will be evaluated and ranked according to the following criteria:

- Evidence of academic achievement (Student Grade Enquiry statement)
- Presentation of a letter from their employer or colleague that supports the application and demonstrates how this award will contribute to his/her continued success in the field and application of Project Management

Note: A formal presentation of this Award will be made at The Chang School Awards ceremony in the Fall 2014 term.

#### **Application Procedures**

The Nick P. Bada Award application form is available online on The Chang School website or may be obtained from The G. Raymond Chang School of Continuing Education, Heaslip House, 297 Victoria Street. Completed applications must be received at the information desk in The Chang School lobby by 4:00 p.m. Friday, August 15, 2014.

Note: Successful candidates will be notified by mail and have their names posted on The Chang School website.

**NOTE:** Students are expected to be honest in providing information on Award applications and in any subsequent discussions. If there is clear evidence that a student has misrepresented her/his circumstances or achievements, the Award will be refused or withdrawn.
