Thank you for your interest in family camp at Horn Creek – a unique experience that combines the majestic setting of the Rocky Mountains with spiritual renewal and challenge from a Christian perspective. Our summer family camps include great meals; a variety of activities for the whole family; and our evening Round Up, a meaningful time of worship and teaching with our great team of leaders and speakers from all over the world. We finish each evening with a different activity after Round Up, like the Hanging Log, Family Game Night, Skit Night, and our weekly Western Night variety show that includes a town party, music and melodrama, and culminates in a huge barn dance!

Please note that all of our summer family camps are 6 nights long, beginning on **Sunday evening**, and running through **Friday evening** (departure on Saturday morning as always). However, if you let us know you're coming, we'll have your room ready, and for just a small fee you may choose to arrive a day early, after 4:00pm on **Saturday**. Saturday evening campers will be on their own for meals with the exception of a simple continental breakfast on Sunday morning, and our Recreation Center will be closed. But it's a great opportunity to explore the valley and get to know the towns of Westcliffe and Silver Cliff, which have wonderful churches for you to visit on Sunday morning and a variety of unique restaurants and great weekend activities throughout the summer like the Bluegrass Festival, Westcliffe Stampede Rodeo, 4<sup>th</sup> of July festivities, antique car show, and much more.

The days of camp offer opportunities for families to spend meaningful time together. Our registration fees include many of our recreational programs with access to our Recreation Center featuring basketball, volleyball, racquetball and an indoor track. Outdoors we provide horseshoes, swimming, waterslides, hiking and fishing (catch-n-release in our own private pond, or explore the many, natural mountain creeks and lakes within hiking distance of camp - bring your own pole and bait). For nominal fees, several other indoor Horn Creek activities are available, including a 30' climbing wall, bowling, and gift and snack shops. Outside, our fee-for-service activities include the alpine swing, high and low ropes courses, and Frisbee golf. Other activities that can be arranged through Horn Creek at a discounted rate are horseback riding, whitewater rafting trips and All Terrain Vehicles (ATV) rentals and tours. Of course, there's always an opportunity to catch an afternoon nap or sit on the porch and enjoy a good book while the kids play and explore!

Dress is casual with two exceptions. We encourage western attire for our weekly **Western Night**. And, dress is generally a little more formal for our **Friday evening** end-of-the-week, multi-course banquet. You may also wish to bring your own props or costumes for our midweek **Skit Night!** 

We are now accepting registrations for the 2014 summer family camp season, and we encourage you to send in your \$75 per person minimum payment along with the enclosed registration form at your earliest convenience to ensure that you get a spot! We will match your family with the room that best fits your family size. If you have special housing needs, let us know in the designated space on the registration form.

Before you complete and send in your registration form, please read carefully the following Horn Creek Family Camp policies. Your signature on the registration form indicates that you have read and understand these guidelines:

- Payment for Camp Your \$75 per person deposit should be submitted along with the
  registration form, unless other arrangements are made with our registration team. Half
  of the Total Camp Fees is due 90 days prior to the start of your camp. The remaining
  balance is due 45 days before you arrive at camp. Horn Creek accepts cash, check,
  money orders, e-checks and credit cards as payment for camp. Please do not mail cash.
- Cancellation Policy and Penalties
  - o Cancellations 60 or more days before camp -\$300 cancellation fee per household.
  - Cancellations less than 60 days before camp You are responsible for the Total Camp Fees.

If circumstances require you to cancel your registration, contact Horn Creek immediately, and make sure you have confirmation from the Horn Creek registration team that your cancellation has been received. Horn Creek always takes into consideration medical or other family emergencies.
