The Department of the History of Art & Architecture is now accepting submissions for 2015-2016 HISTORY OF ART AND ARCHITECTURE UNDERGRADUATE ESSAY PRIZES.

Prizes, in the form of books, will be awarded to the best essay in each of the following three categories:

- The Marian Donnelly Prize is awarded to an essay on any area of Art History
- The Marion Dean Ross Prize is awarded to an essay on Architectural History
- The Ellen Johnston Laing Prize is awarded to an essay on Asian Art

Essays or term papers written for any History of Art and Architecture courses (prefix ARH) in Spring 2015, Summer 2015, Fall 2015, or Winter 2016 are eligible for consideration.

Successful essays are typically well-composed research papers with proper citations (Chicago style is most common for art history). Students are allowed (and encouraged) to rework, re-edit and improve papers prior to submission.

Students may submit essays (or the same essay) in more than one category.
