# 2016–2017 PRIMARY SCHOOL APPLICATION

Applications for K-8 primary programs are due with a copy of the child's birth certificate, previous school records when applicable, and the non-refundable \$100 fee by February 5th. Once all parts of the application have been filed —parent short answer questions, student self-portrait, teacher recommendation—a student visitation day and parent conference will be scheduled. The mandatory kindergarten visit program is February 20th from 9:00 to noon; upper grade applications participate in a full-day classroom visitation at their current grade level, between February 16–25. Admission notifications are sent towards the end of March and require a 10% tuition deposit to confirm placement. Late applications are reviewed on a space available basis.
