### **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

The Greater Milwaukee Brittany Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Greater Milwaukee Brittany club or any official thereof.

Dogs must be ready for judging. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dog in the ring.

Exhibitors will be permitted to have crates at ringside. Those crates must be against the baby gates. Do not block the aisles, absolutely no grooming tables ringside. All crates must be removed from ringside at the completion of your show. The same rules will be enforced on Saturday. If your club is providing ex pens, you must coordinate the set up of those ex pens with me & my grounds crew.

For those who do not buy reserve grooming must set up into the Pavilion. Your club may rope off a reasonable size area on Friday morning for the Brittany's & your club must control that area. But come Saturday morning any area that hasn't been taken, other exhibitors may be allowed to move into that area.

#### **BREED COMPETITION**

Effective for all shows held on or after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

A recording fee of \$.50 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This recording fee is to be collected by the Show-Giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). Effective for all events held on or after January 1, 2008, The American Kennel Club will collect a \$3.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.)

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from the competition by action of the show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to complete the show, no refund of entry fee shall be made.
