SHARE A HOME FOR CARE!

Are you looking for companionship and help around the house? Carers in other areas of London have already discovered Novus Homeshare: this is a high quality scheme that matches younger people looking for affordable accommodation and who are willing to help out around the house for a minimum of 10 hours per week, with older or disabled people or couples who have a spare room and need some support.

Homeshare staff personally interview all applicants and visit your home to ensure they find the right match for you. The Novus Homeshare team focuses on the quality of their service and the personal touch. They undertake detailed checks and matching for all applicants to make sure that this arrangement works well for both parties. Your carefully selected lodger will rent a room in your home and provide you with ten hours care and support each week. A small fee to Novus Homeshare is paid monthly by both the Householder and their Homesharer for the matching and ongoing support This type of live-in support doesn't replace a full care service, but can be used alongside care support. It also provides the peace and security of having someone there every night when perhaps family and friends aren't able to be.

MindCare Dementia Support

Lewisham MindCare Dementia Information and Support Service help people with Dementia living in the Borough of Lewisham. To enhance the support MindCare have a small pool of volunteers with a variety of roles and are always welcoming new volunteers. There are a range of volunteer opportunities:

•Befrienders to make home visits to people who cannot get out and provide valuable social contact;

•Supporting people to take part in group activities;

•Volunteer escorts to support people to attend hospital/medical appointments or community groups.

Mindcare are interested in male and female volunteers from all backgrounds and ages. No experience of supporting people with dementia is necessary as they provide full training.

Face 2 Face emotional support for parents

Caring for a disabled child can be tough. When you're juggling work, household tasks and countless medical appointments for your child, there's little time left for you. Many parents feel alone and unsupported.

How they can help you

Face 2 Face is a free and confidential befriending service offering one-toone emotional support for parents of disabled children or those with additional needs. The service is provided by trained befrienders who will support you to navigate through the worrying and confused experience of having a child diagnosed with support needs.

So if you are caring for a disabled child this service is for you. You can use the service even if your child has not been diagnosed. You'll meet a befriender who is a trained listener, there for you if you want to laugh, cry or simply let off steam about your day. All our befrienders are parents of disabled children, so they know better than most where you're coming from.

Sessions take place in your home, or at a nearby location of your choice, and last around an hour. You might want to meet your befriender just once or twice, or for a few months. You and your befriender will decide what's best for you.

Keep Warm and Healthy in Winter

Many people, worried about fuel costs will ration their heating and electricity this winter but the reality is that this will have an impact on their physical and mental health. Every year in Lewisham 90 extra people die over the winter months because of the cold.

Keeping warm can help prevent colds, flu, heart attacks, strokes, pneumonia and depression. The chances of these problems are higher if you're vulnerable to cold-related illnesses because:

- you're over 65 you're on a low income you have a long-term health condition such as heart, lung or kidney disease
- you are disabled
- you are pregnant
- you are a child under 5 years old

If you fit into one of the above categories, or you know someone who does, you or they will be eligible for additional support through the Lewisham Warm Homes Healthy People scheme. It provides a free home energy check, free draught proofing, a free winter warm pack, free insulation and much more. IT Hub

Do you need help accessing advice and information on line? Do you need help with claiming non-disability benefits online?

Funded by the Big Lottery, and in partnership with Advice Lewisham, we have launched an IT hub at the Carers Centre in Forest Hill, which will be open every Friday.

You can use our computers and trained Advice Lewisham staff / volunteers will be available to assist you.

CARERS LEWISHAM—**ONE STOP ADVICE AND INFORMATION HUB FOR CARERS** Carers Lewisham continues to offer **one stop advice and information support** to anyone with caring responsibilities.

We offer advice and information on the phone, by email and by appointment. If necessary we can visit you in your own home (mainly for elderly or disabled carers) or you can make an appointment at the Carers Centre in Forest Hill.

We can advise you about a wide range of caring-related matters including benefits, services, how to get a break, how to cope with challenging behaviours, dealing with difficult relationships, considering your own future, residential care, whether or not to give up your paid work or return to work, etc. etc. All our services and advice are delivered in an holistic way putting YOUR needs as the carer first and our services are FREE.
