Reference Letter for REU Program

(REU) program in Physics & Astronomy at Louisiana State University, requests a letter of reference from you. The application deadline is March 1, 2012; we ask that letters be received by this date.

We ask that you submit a written letter of recommendation on your institution's letterhead, as well as return this page with the information below completed. A substantial part of our evaluation will be based on your written letter. Please use the letter to describe the student's qualifications for participating in a Research Experience for Undergraduates program. Items of particular interest include:

- scholastic aptitude;
- work ethic and maturity;
- motivation and aptitude for research;
- particular strengths or weaknesses;
- ability to flourish in group and/or semi-independent situations;
- whether you would choose to work with this student as a research mentor;
- how well you know the applicant; and
- relative ranking of applicant among his/her peers.

As part of REU program participation, the student will prepare a written report and present a poster at our annual Summer Undergraduate Research Forum. We hope that you can provide your student with an opportunity to give an additional poster presentation or department seminar at his/her home institution during the Fall semester following the REU program.
