

Carol L. White Award

What is the Carol L. White Award?

• An annual award of \$500 to assist an ATC Phi Theta Kappa member currently pursuing an Associate Degree

How can this scholarship be used?

• Tuition, fees, books, supplies, online learning resources or disbursed directly to scholarship recipient

What are the criteria for eligibility?

- Student must be a Phi Theta Kappa member in good standing at Athens Technical College
- Student must have completed 12.0 semester hours of coursework towards an Associate Degree at Athens Technical College
- Student must have a 3.5 GPA or higher

What are the required documents?

Completed Application

- **Resume** (please attach to application packet, **MUST** include the following information)
 - Name and ATC Student ID number
 - Current mailing address and student email address
 - Educational background
 - Work history, school/community activities
 - Honors, recognitions and awards
- Letter of Recommendation (please attach to application packet)
 - Letter of recommendation from an ATC program director or instructor
- **Three short essays addressing the following questions:** (please attach to application packet)
 - Describe your most significant leadership roles in projects related to the Chapter's Hallmark or Chapter development goals, and the impact of these contributions on the chapter, college, community and region
 - Provide specific examples of how you positively influenced one or more chapter officers and members
 - Provide specific examples of how you distinguished yourself from other members in the chapter

When is the application due?

- Application MUST be received in the Athens Tech Foundation Office, Room F-136 by 4:00pm, Thursday, April 4, 2013
- NO EXCEPTIONS

When is the scholarship awarded?

- Award recipient will be announced on Thursday, April 26, 2013. Applicants will be notified via student email
- Please DO NOT call the Financial Aid or Athens Tech Foundation Offices to check application status

How do you get the funds?

• To process scholarship, recipient must visit the Financial Aid Office, Room H-700

When will the scholarship funds be available to use?

• Funds will be available after scholarship recipient provides proof of registration for the award term(s) to Athens Tech Foundation

A student will be required to reimburse their scholarship if they withdraw from classes within seven calendar days of the start of the term, or if they drop a course during the official drop/add period.

Any funds not used by the end of the aid year will be returned to the Athens Tech Foundation.
