



Early Childhood Care & Education Parkview Scholarship (Fall)

What is the Early Childhood Care & Education Parkview Scholarship?

- A scholarship awarded to students (up to five per semester) enrolled in the Early Childhood Care & Education Associate Degree program.
- The **maximum** award is \$255

How can this scholarship be used?

- Tuition for MATH0098 OR MATH 0099. Students are eligible to receive this scholarship one time.

What are the criteria for eligibility?

- Student **MUST** be enrolled in the Early Childhood Care & Education Associate Degree program
- Student **MUST** have completed 16.0 semester hours of work at Athens Technical College in the Early Childhood Care & Education program.
- Student **MUST** have a 3.0 GPA or higher.

What are the required documents?

- Completed Application**
- Resume** (please attach to application packet, **MUST** include the following information)
 - Name and ATC Student ID number
 - Current mailing address and student email address
 - Educational background
 - Work history, school/community activities
 - Honors, recognitions and awards
- Letter of Recommendation** (please attach to application packet)
 - **ONE** letter of recommendation from an ATC program director or instructor
- Letter to Selection Committee** (please attach to application packet, **MUST** include the following information)
 - General information about applicant
 - Applicant's educational and professional goals
 - Why applicant chose ATC
 - Why applicant feels they should receive this scholarship
 - Attributes applicant possesses that show evidence of good citizenship, work ethics and school/community leadership

When is the application due?

- Application **MUST** be received in the **Athens Tech Foundation Office, Room F-136 by 4:00pm, Tuesday, November 5, 2013**
- **NO EXCEPTIONS**

When is the scholarship awarded?

- **Scholarship recipient will be announced on Thursday, December 5, 2013.** Applicants will be notified via student email
- **Please DO NOT call the Financial Aid or Athens Tech Foundation Offices to check application status**

How do you get the funds?

- To process scholarship, recipient must visit the Financial Aid Office, Room H-700

When will the scholarship funds be available to use?

- Funds will be available after scholarship recipient provides proof of registration for the award term(s) to Athens Tech Foundation
