## NGSA Information For The 2009 Season:

T-ball (Ages 5&6): Practices and games are at Holland Elementary School. Practices start the first week of April. Games start in May and run through the end of the school year.

8&U: This is our coach-pitched division. Practices and games are at Holland Elementary School. Practices start the first week of April. Games start in May and run through the end of the school year.

10&U: At this level the girls start pitching. Practices and games are at Churchville Elementary School. Practices start the first week of April. Games start in May and run through the end of the school year and include playoffs. Games are parent umpired.

Teams in the 12U, 14U and 18U age groups play in an inter-township league with games against intramural teams from surrounding organizations such as Warminster, Upper Southampton, Tri-Township and Newtown. There will be an inseason inter-township intramural tournament in mid-May and playoffs in June. All girls in these age groups must have batting helmets that include a chin strap and face guard. Girls can use their own, otherwise each team has team helmets. These can also be purchased from NGSA for individual use. Please call 215-364-2344 and leave a message and you will be contacted with information. Girls also learn bunting, sliding and stealing starting at the 12U level. Therefore it is recommended that all players have knee pads and compression (sliding) shorts (worn beneath the uniform) to protect against injury. These items can also be purchased from NGSA. Facilities used include Welch Elementary School (12U and 14U), the Civic Center (14U and 18U), and the fields at Council Rock South High School (14U and 18U).

Please note that the registration deadline has been moved up so as to better accommodate the deadlines established for ordering uniforms. We will have free player clinics during March. Information will be sent out after January. Games/practices start no earlier than 5:30 so as to not interfere with after school activities/sports.

Please remember that:

- NGSA will not honor requests for players to play up in a higher age group even if the parent is the coach.
- NGSA will try to honor requests to be on a friend's team.
- Refund requests must be received by April 15<sup>th</sup>. Refunds are subject to a \$25 administrative fee.
