Please join us for our annual Lunch on the Lawn, Sunday, April 22 (also Earth Day!) at noon benefitting St. Mark's Community Garden. Tickets are \$10 for adults and \$5 per child. Tickets will be on sale between services in the breezeway and at the luncheon. We will be inside if there is rain.

The menu will include homemade hummus and pita chips, deviled eggs, brisket, chicken salad, potato salad, kale salad, homemade rolls, pickles, Hello Dolly! bars, raspberry streusel squares, and pecan pie. Yum!

St. Mark's members and neighborhood friends volunteer daily in the garden to provide hundreds of pounds of fresh fruits and vegetables a year for the Heights Interfaith Ministries Food Pantry located at 3523 Beauchamp. The HIM Food Pantry has served more than 8,700 families (including over 33,000 people) in the 77007, 77008 and 77009 zip codes since its inception almost three years ago. The monies raised will help buy rich dirt, seeds, plants and materials to build more beds for planting.
