## Maketewa Spring Camporee

Risks and rules specific to this outing

This is a spring camping trip that could involve cold and/or wet temperatures. We will camp regardless of the weather, so Scouts should be prepared to ward off hypothermia with adequate rain gear, sturdy, comfortable foot wear and warm layered clothing. There is no service project planned at the moment. As the scout motto says "Be prepared" and bring appropriate clothing in case a service project is organized.

Scouts and adults should never cross any Caution Tape. The Clermont County Airport is has a LIVE runway and taxiway. ANY scout or adult found violating this rule will be sent home. Do not touch any aircraft unless told by the owner.

NO GROUND FIRES – all fire must be elevated. Cook with fuel stoves or charcoal where possible. There is NO scrounge wood available. All wood (NO ASH) must be brought with you. All unused wood must be taken home.

**Leave No Trace** - All garbage put in tightly closed bags/cans and *taken home* with you. All ashes from stoves and above ground fires put in Ash Barrel.

**Lights Out/Quiet Time:** We ask that all Scouts be in their campsite and in their tents by 11:00pm with Quiet Time observed until 6:00am.

Commands from all Scoutmasters, Camporee Staff, & Rangemasters must be obeyed. No activities can be used without proper staff supervision present at the activity. Scouts not following rules, procedures or commands will be asked to leave. (This camporee will be staffed with medical professionals.) As in all Scouting events, no alcohol, drugs, fireworks. firearms, pornography or inappropriate/unsafe behavior will be permitted.
