Religious Education

CCD Registrations are taken in the Rectory in the Office of Religious Education. The registration fee is \$75 per child for the months of September/October. Please call the Rectory and make an appointment to register. New families are asked to bring in the child's baptism records and other sacrament records if the child is older.

The CCD schedule is as follows:

Sunday : Grades 1, 2, and 3 at 9:15 a.m.
Grades 8 and 9 at 10:30 a.m.

Tuesday: Grade 7 at 6:30 p.m.

Thursday: Grades 4, 5, and 6 at 6:30 p.m.

Altar Servers: All of the children, grades 3-8 will automatically be scheduled for altar serving Masses during the Church-school year. The Religious Education Office will schedule children to satisfy their obligation to serve Mass at 5 p.m. Saturday evening, and at all scheduled Masses on Sunday. The Celebrants, Deacon, and experienced altar servers will assist and instruct the children on all the details of serving. This is a wonderful learning experience.

Children who are scheduled for altar serving will be excused from class on their assigned day if it is **during class time**. Children will not be marked absent on that day. However, they will be responsible for the religion textbook lesson for the week.
