#### 39th UPU Letter Writing Competition for Young People, 2010.

#### **RULES FOR PARTICIPANTS**

- (a) The 39<sup>th</sup> Universal Postal Union (UPU) Letter Writing competition shall be open to school going children up to 15 years of as on 31.03.2010.
- (b) The age of participants is to be certified by the school authorities where the participant is studying.
- (c) Date by which participants should declare their 20.12.2009
  Intention to participation the competition (last date)
  to CPMG/PMG / School Principal
- (d) Date and time of the 'on the spot competition'. 03.01.2010 10.00 to 11.00hrs.
- (e) The participants will make their own arrangements to reach the venue of the competition. The Department / schools will provide the answer books for the competition to the children but they will bring their own pen/ pencil etc.
- (f) All the candidates shall be required to apply in person to the Chief Postmaster General / Postmaster General / School Principal in duplicate. Both copies must have a passport size photograph of the candidate affixed on them.
- (g) The participants will apply for participation in the competition along with three passport size photographs in the following format on plain paper.
- 1. Name of the competition 39<sup>th</sup> UPU Letter Writing Competition for young people 2010.
- II. Full Name of the participant
- III. Father's / Guardian's Name.
- IV. Full Address for correspondence.
- V. Name of the School/ Institution where studying with full details.
- VI. Age with exact date of birth to be Certified by the Head of the Educational Institution.
- VII Sex (Male / Female)
- VIII Centre.
- (h) Entry in the examination Hall will be by Hall permits to be issued by the Chief Postmasters General / Postmaster General/School Principal concerned. Each participant will be allotted a Roll No. by the concerned Chief Postmaster General / Postmaster General / School Principal.

<u>IMPORTANT:-</u> All the particulars as mentioned above including the full name and address of the participant should appear on the first page of the Answer Book also. Entries, which do not furnish all relevant details, would not be considered valid.

#### **DEPARTMENTAL INSTRUCTIONS**

- (1) The evaluation of all entries including entries in regional language will be done at the Circle level by the examiners selected by the Circle Heads from amongst the officers of the Department.
- (2) In case, a circle is receiving entries in regional languages other than the regional language of the circle and it is not a position to get them evaluated /translated such entries may be sent to the appropriate Circle with the request that the same may be got evaluated/ translated, under intimation to the Directorate.
- (3) After evaluation, best three (3) entries from each circle may be forwarded to the Directorate. In case there are any regional entries amongst the best three (3) entries, such entries may be got translated into English and such regional entries along with its English translation may be sent to the Directorate. Rest of the entries may be kept in the circle.
- (4) The examiners may be instructed to give weightage while evaluating the entries to:
  - a) Correctness of language
  - b) Coherence -logical development
  - c) Originality of the ideas
  - d) Style of writing
  - e) Theme; and
  - f) Format of the letter
- (5) It is to be specifically ensured that no invigilator is posted at a Centre where his /her son/ daughter near relative etc., is appearing. This is very important.
- (6) The duration of the competition will be one hour and the maximum marks allotted are 100 (One hundred).
- (7) To give publicity to the Letter Writing Competition, an advertisement on All India level is being issued from Directorate. The Circles may also release advertisements in local newspapers through DAVP. The

Circles may also print suitable posters and take other publicity measurers in the light of their experience in the past. The copies of the advertisements can also be sent to the local State level educational institutions for better response.

All the applications and hall permits received from the participants are to be preserved in the offices of CPMG / PMG School Principal till the process of selection of the prize-winning entries and distribution of awards is completed.

The Universal Postal Union shall select the award winning entries. The top three entries will be awarded Gold, Silver and Bronz Medal respectively along with Certificate and album of UPU official postage stamps from UPU.
