Election Worker Application



Eligibility Requirements

To serve as an election worker, you are required to be:

- · District resident and
- A registered voter in DC.

Selection Process

You will be selected based upon need. If positions are available, you will be contacted by BOE staff a few months prior to the election. Not all applicants are selected to serve and not all applicants selected are assigned to their home polling place.

Work Requirements

Election workers must:

- Complete a training class prior to the election;
- Assist in setting up the polling place for a few hours the day before the election;
- And work at an assigned polling place on Election Day from 6 a.m. until approximately 9 p.m.
