TABS FOR KIDS

As you open and enjoy your bubbly beverage, you might think how it quenches your thirst. How cold and wet it is going down your hot, parched throat. That it refreshes and revives you on even your bluest times. Many people don't know that it can also help a child in need.

A LITTLE PIECE OF HELP

When you look at a can of your favorite beverage, you see a design, a logo and even a list of ingredients and nutrition information. The can is made of aluminum, which in certain states might be redeemed for as much as a dime. But did you know that the tabs that you use to open the can with are worth something too? Your local Shriners collect theselit-tle pieces of aluminum and cash them in. All sales benefit Shriners Hospitals for children 100%.

WHY THEY DO IT

The Shriners collect the pull-tabs for 3 reasons; First, by recycling the aluminum the Shriners are being environmentally friendly, this is because it requires approximately 15% of the total energy to recycle the already refined aluminum rather than mine new aluminum. It allows others to help without additional cost to them. And, most importantly, it's also another way to help kids receive care regardless of patients' or their parents' ability to pay at the Shriner's Hospitals for Children .

WHY JUST THE TABS?


The answer to the question of why the tab and not the whole can is because of the size and the amount of space to store it in. Pull the tab off of your beverage can and look at it in comparison to the can itself. The can is 26.5 times as heavy and much larger than the tab, yet there is as much aluminum (or maybe more) in the tab as there is in the whole rest of the can. It takes roughly 35 cans to equal a pound of aluminum and about 930 tabs to equal that same pound with less space. So, the Shriner who is collecting these tabs is able to take more tabs than he would be cans. That helps turn more into usable money for the Shriners Hospitals.

NOW YOU KNOW

With all of this in mind, take that tab in your hand and donate it right away to your local Shrine Club. A tab can make a difference in a child's life as much as a dime can make a difference. How REFRESHING is that?

The first Shriners Hospital opened in 1922, Shreveport, LA Now the number of Shriners Hospitals for children is: 22 ; 20 in the U.S and 1 each in Canada and Mexico.

Any child up to the age 18 is eligible for care if, there is a reasonable possibility the child will benefit from available services. Acceptance is based solely on a child's medical needs. All care and services are provided regardless of the families ability to pay.

Good News! Services Extended at the Chicago Shriners Hospital

In an effort to accommodate the needs of the community, the Chicago Shriners Hospital is pleased to announce they offer extended rehab outpatient services weekly from 7am-6pm.

The rehabilitation department now provides weekly recurring outpatient visits as well as intensive visits for one to two week periods in which patients receive up to five sessions of therapy a day, with physical therapy (PT), occupational therapy (OT) and speech combined. Rehab is working increasingly with children with cerebral palsy and orthopedic conditions post- surgery, and are offering athletic injury rehab for rotator cuff and ACL injuries.

Anna Mueller, speech language pathologist (SLP), works with patients needing augmentative and alternate communication. Anna is looking to start a feeding clinic for patients with eating and swallowing disorders.

The rehab department continues to recruit patients for clinical research projects, including Lokomat studies. With rehab taking direct referrals, please call Shriners Hospital today at (773)385-KIDS if you know a child who could benefit from their expert service.


