INFANT MILK – SUMMER TERM 2014

To the Parents of children in Key Stage 1

School milk is available next term at the cost of £12.60 to all children in the Infant Department. However those children in the Reception class who will be 4 for the whole of the Summer term, ie, those who have their 5th birthday after 23rd July 2014 are entitled to free school milk under the Nursery Milk Scheme. Mid-morning milk is good for the children and is being provided at a reduced price as a result of European Community subsidy.

If you would like your child to have milk:

- and they will be aged 5 or over on 23rd July 2014, please send the exact cash or cheque made payable to "Herts County Council" in an envelope marked 'SCHOOL MILK' together with your child's name and class.
- and they will reach the age of 5 after 23rd July 2014, they will be entitled to milk **free of charge** during the Summer Term.

PLEASE NOTE:

Children receiving free school meals for next term will also be entitled to milk free of charge.

Please return the reply-slip below, even if you do not intend for your child to receive school milk by **Friday 21st March 2014** at the latest (orders will not be able to be accepted after this date).
