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Soccer schools application guidelines and terms and conditions

- 1) The soccer schools will take place at the May and Baker Sports and Social Club From Wednesday 3rd April 2013 to Friday 5th April**
- 2) Course will run each day between 10.00am and 3pm. Participants are required to bring their own packed lunch and drinks with them**
- 3) All participants under the age of 12 must be brought onto site by a responsible adult who must register the child with the coaches on a daily basis before leaving the site. All young people attending the afternoon session must register with the coaches when arriving at the site. Children must be collected promptly at the end of each day, and the head coach MUST have signed your child out.**
- 4) If for any reason a child or young person has to leave the soccer school before the end of a session then the head coach must be informed by one of the adults detailed on the application form before the child leaves.**
- 5) Swearing, bad behaviour, or violence towards other participants or staff will not be tolerated and will result in the child / young person being asked to leave the soccer school and may result in a ban from any future soccer school.**
- 6) Parents/ guardians are responsible for ensuring that participants bring with them: Sufficient drinks to ensure that their child/ young person remains hydrated. Any medication required and sunscreen and that their child knows how to apply the sunscreen.**
