


WHEREAS, Section 19-4022 of the Nebraska Revised Statutes provides that a Business Improvement Board shall consist of five or more members; and,

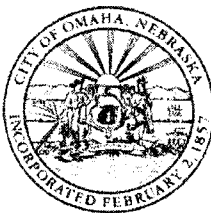
