## Dr. Robin Knowles Wallace



Robin Knowles Wallace, Professor of Worship and Music at Methodist Theological School in Ohio, received her Ph.D. in theology and worship from Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary and Northwestern University. Her other degrees are a B.A. in music from the University of Cincinnati, an M.A. in church music from Scarritt College, and a Masters in Theological Studies from Candler School of Theology at Emory University.

Prior to her doctoral studies, Robin served as a church musician (organist and choir director) for twenty-five years. She has published seven books to date:

- *Things they Never Tell You Before You Say 'Yes': The Non-Musical Tasks of the Church Musician*, 1994
- *Moving Toward Emancipatory Language: A Study of Six Recent Hymns*, 1999
- *Communion Services: Just In Time*, 2006
- *Palm Sunday and Holy Week Services: Just in Time*, 2006
- *Worship in Small Membership Churches*, with Rev. Terry Heck, 2007
- *Worshiping in the Small Membership Church*, 2008
- *The Christian Year: Guide for Worship and Preaching*, 2011

In addition, Robin is a contributing writer to twelve books on worship and hymnody, the author of over 60 articles in journals, and a frequent presenter at events in the United States and recently in Great Britain. She currently edits *The Hymn: A Journal of Congregational Song* for The Hymn Society in the United States and Canada.

Robin is an authorized minister in the United Church of Christ, Central Southeast Ohio Association. Robin is the mother of two daughters—Laura, studying at the University of Texas, Austin, and Grace, living in Columbus, Ohio.
