The award will be paid directly to the student, and can be used for any expenses related to legal education, including but not limited to tuition, room, board, books, bar review courses, or commuting expenses.

Candidates should submit a cover letter summarizing their interest in intellectual property law to heather.kemp@brownpc.com. Cover letters should also include the following information:

Candidates are encouraged to submit, along with their letter, any documents demonstrating their interest in intellectual property law. Documents might include a transcript or class schedule showing intellectual property law courses completed or currently enrolled in, a letter of recommendation from an intellectual property law professor or a letter from someone who supervised the applicant in an intellectual property law-related job or internship.

The deadline for submissions is Friday, December 12th, 2014 and the award will be announced on Friday, December 19th, 2014.
