## National Scholarship

The Henry G. Huestis Memorial Scholarship

(For veterans and active military including National Guard & Reserves) (\$1,000)

AMVETS is proud to announce the establishment of The Henry G. Huestis Memorial Scholarship. The scholarship is in memory of and honoring Henry G. Huestis and is awarded annually.

One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded nation-wide per year, for the duration of the five year grant. The scholarships are for veterans, and active duty including members of the National Guard and Reserves, seeking new skills in order to be more competitive in the job market. The one-time \$1,000 award may be used for part time or full time undergraduate courses, accredited degree or certificate programs, including online schools.

#### Biographical sketch of Henry G. Huestis

Henry Huestis was born in Bethpage, N.Y. and attended Bethpage High School. He was always interested in electronics, and shortly after high school he was drafted into the Air Force where he worked in communications during the Vietnam War. After his time in Vietnam at Da Nang Air Base, Henry, like many veterans of his generation, had issues readjusting back to civilian life. Henry received an honorable discharge, moved to Spokane, Wash., and attended Washington State University. He was very passionate about education and always sought to better himself. Throughout his life, Henry was active with Veterans Affairs hospitals, as he thought our veterans should be treated better and have more opportunities to succeed. Henry is buried at Calverton Veteran Cemetery in Long Island, N.Y. In the spirit of helping veterans, the Huestis Family feels honored and blessed to establish the Henry G. Huestis, Memorial Scholarship to hopefully allow a veteran to become a prosperous and successful member of society through educational opportunities. Henry would be proud to have a scholarship established in his name, and would have been thrilled to offer hope to a veteran and give this individual an opportunity to realize his or her educational goals.

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance for veterans/guardsmen/reservists who have exhausted government aid, or who might not otherwise have the financial means to further their education. Applicants must meet all of the eligibility requirements listed below and submit the completed application postmarked on or before April 15. For questions regarding the application, required documents, or application process, please contact AMVETS toll free at 877-726-8387.

#### **Eligibility Requirements:**

- 1. Must be a United States citizen.
- 2. Must demonstrate financial need.
- 3. Must have a high school diploma or GED. (General Education Diploma)
- 4. Must agree to authorize AMVETS to publicize your scholarship award, if you are selected.
- 5. <u>Must</u> be enrolled or accepted for enrollment to an eligible program.
- 6. Must not be in default on a federal student loan.
- 7. Must not be convicted under state or federal law of sale or possession of illegal drugs.

Completed application and required forms must be postmarked on or before April 15.

#### Required Materials

- 1. A copy of the veteran's honorable discharge or a letter from the commanding officer certifying current Guard or Reserve status.
- 2. Official college transcripts for all courses attempted and any degrees or certificates awarded. If post-secondary credits amount to less than 12 credit hours and high school diploma was awarded within the past five years, a high school transcript must be provided. Transcripts must be in the 4.0 grade scale or if in a different system, translated to the 4.0 scale.
- 3. A complete and signed copy of the applicant's 1040 tax form must be enclosed. It will be used to verify financial need.
- 4. A copy of the applicant's Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- 5. Essay (50-100 words) and addressing the theme of how this scholarship will help me:
  - "This Award will help me achieve my career/vocational goal, which is \_\_\_\_\_."

    (The essay must be written in the space provided on page 3.)
- 6. Acceptance letter or a letter stating current student status from an accredited program.
- 7. A resume detailing military duty and awards, volunteer activities, community services, and jobs held during the past four years.
