## Math Placement

Math placements are based on a reliable matrix used in the M-S district for nearly 20 years. The matrix considers the following factors: 8<sup>th</sup> grade math course, grades, Orleans-Hanna Algebra Prognosis Test, 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Math Standardized Scores, and homework/work ethic.

Incoming freshmen will be placed in Pre-Algebra, Algebra IA, Algebra I, or Honors Geometry.

## Overview

Mahomet Seymour High School offers over 100 courses to challenge each student to reach his/her potential. Class periods are forty-nine minutes in length, five days per week.

Students receive one-half credit per semester for each course successfully completed [excluding Physical Education (.25 credits), and Driver's Education (0.0 credits)].

Lunch periods are assigned based on a student's 4<sup>th</sup> period class. Schedules, including teacher assignments, are made randomly. Requests for a specific schedule and/or teacher cannot be honored.

## Graduation Requirements

20 academic credits are required for graduation, including the following courses:

- 4.0 credits in English, including Speech Communication
- 3.0 credits in Mathematics
- 2.0 credits in Science
- 2.0 credits in Social Studies, including one credit of U.S. History and one-half credit of consumer education or its equivalent
- 1.0 credit in World Language, Fine Arts, or Vocational Education
- 0.5 credit in Health

## College Requirements

College-bound students will be encouraged to take additional courses in core academic areas. Please refer to the Course Selection Guide for more details.
