



SERA/SEDRA 100 Mile Achievement Award Nomination

Introduction: The Southeast Endurance Riders Association (SERA) and the South Eastern Distance Riding Association (SEDRA) have joined forces in a program to stimulate the growth in these foundations to the sport of long distance horse back riding in the Southeastern United States.

One 100 Mile Achievement Award: This award is established in order to reward the achievement in the 100-mile or greater distance ride. The time duration for completion of the requirements for the award is open ended and can be done at the riders pace. The sport of distance riding is about the bond between the horse and rider. This is an award that goes to a horse and rider team.

Award Requirement: To receive this recognition, the same rider on the same horse (rider/horse team) must successfully complete three events in any combination of a Three Day 100 Mile Competitive Trail Ride, a Two Day 100 Mile Endurance ride, Pioneer Endurance ride or a One Day 100 Mile Endurance ride. To be eligible for consideration the competitive trail ride must be SEDRA sanctioned and the endurance rides must be both SERA and SEDRA sanctioned. There is a \$20.00 nomination fee.
