### **Client Report**

In eight months, through August 31, 2013, volunteers served 290 client families on 729 office visits. Monday (211 visits) and Tuesday (193 visits) evenings continue to be the busiest for client visits. We have met:

- 495 requests for infant clothing
- 185 requests for formula
- 66 requests for baby food
- 677 requests for diapers

- 28 requests for car seats
- 34 requests for cribs
- 32 requests for mattresses

Volunteers have served 658 hours meeting client needs and keeping the office and shelves organized. Material donors number 163.

A single father recently sued for custody of his one-year old. After winning custody, he turned to Birthcare for baby food, diapers, clothing, wipes, and toys. He is currently unemployed.
