We also rode to the Region F Rally in Las Vegas. It was about 25 degrees when we left Albuquerque and around Gallup it dropped to 19 and the roads appeared to be wet, because there had been snow there the day before and they had closed I40 toward Flagstaff. But we made it fine and enjoyed 3 days of 80 degrees in Las Vegas.

- ERC** (One-up) Learn advanced techniques in turning, maximum braking, swerving and other possible lifesaving techniques plus mental skills and situation strategies for the single rider. 5.5 hours (range only).
- ERC** (Two-up) This course offers the same basic principles as the ERC with the added element of a corider. 5.5 hours (range only).
