The number and availability of courses is dependent upon the number of participants. You will be notified of your class time and location as soon as possible.

Note: Certific	cotion cost is per bike!*
ERC	(One-up) Learn advanced techniques in turning, maximum braking, swerving and other possible lifesaving techniques plus mental skills and situation strategies for the single rider. 5.5 hours (range only).
ERC	(Two-up) This course offers the same basic principles as the ERC with the added element of a co-rider. 5.5 hours (range only).
GWRRA ARC	Experience advanced techniques in turning, maximum braking, and swerving techniques plus mental and situational strategies in GWVRRA's own Advanced Rider Caurse. 8.0 hours (classroom & range).
Sidecar	This course offers advanced techniques of riding with a sidecar as well as situation strategies and accident avoidance tactics. δ hours (3 classroom/3 riding).
Trailering	Learn advanced trailering techniques and strategies for safe and enjoyable trayel. Motorcycles only, no trikes or sidecars please. 6 hours (3 classroom/3 riding).
Trike	This course teaches advanced riding skills for the trike rider such as maximum braking, swerving and turning. 6 haurs (3 classroom/3 riding).
