The Sacramento Chapter of APWA encourages agencies and local members to gain recognition for their outstanding public works projects by nominating these projects for the Chapter's 2015 Project of the Year honors. To be considered, agencies and/or local members need to submit a nomination package by Monday, July 13, 2015. Awards will be given out at the Project of the Year Luncheon to be held on Friday, August 7, 2015. Project of the Year honors will be awarded to public agencies based on <u>Division</u> (construction cost and population served) and <u>Category</u>.

Projects eligible for an award are physical structures and facilities that are developed, owned and maintained by public agencies to house government functions and provide water, power, waste disposal, transportation, and similar public To be considered for a 2015 Chapter award, projects must be "substantially complete" and available for public and/or agency use within two calendar years prior to nomination. If a project has multiple phases or segments, then "substantially completed" shall be construed as that point when the final phase or segment is 90% completed and available for public and/or agency use. Also, the project must be located within the Chapter boundaries. Chapter boundaries are shown on the Chapter website. Projects previously submitted, but not selected as winners, may be nominated again if the project meets the completion timeline.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Criteria to be used in the selection process include:

- Completion date contained in the contract. Any time extensions granted should be addressed in the nomination.
- Construction schedule, management, and control techniques used. Use of alternative materials, practices of funding that demonstrates a commitment to sustainability.
- Safety performance including number of lost-time injuries per 1,000 man hours worked and overall safety program employed during the construction phase.
- Environmental considerations including special steps taken to preserve and protect the environment, endangered species, etc., during the construction phase.
- Community Relations; a summary of the efforts by the managing agency/project owner, consultant, and contractor to protect public lives and property, minimize public inconvenience, and improve relations.
- Unusual accomplishments under adverse conditions, including but not limited to, adverse weather, soil or site conditions, or other occurrences over which there was no control.
- Additional considerations you would like to bring to the attention of the Awards Committee, such as innovations in technology and/or management applications during the project.

NOTE: Supporting documentation is limited to 20 pages, exclusive of photographs and Nomination Form.

Photographs will be used in recognizing the project at the Awards Luncheon.
