Chairman's Corner

Summertime

Is there any other time as delightful and rich as summertime? It just seems that God's colors of the world are more vibrant and enticing during the all too brief summer months. Yes, the living does seem so easy... In the recent past our community faced the challenge (or as some believe, the opportunity) of holding our two summer Walks at a site other than Normandy Church. The Greater Dayton Emmaus Board addressed this situation with prayer, determination and a committee to investigate other sites for the summer Walks. Through the guidance of the Holy Spirit and God's inexhaustible grace, a site was secured for the 2013 summer Walks, and the Emmaus community will continue to fulfill its mission for God's people. It is a story whose ending has yet to occur.

Perhaps this is a time for introspection regarding what we have experienced. While I am not attempting to speak for the Board or the Emmaus community, I am able to summarize remarks and conversations related to finding a new "summer place." First, it is certainly possible to characterize this experience as yet another faith journey, as some in our community expressed considerable doubts regarding our ability to locate another suitable site. Others seemed to be stuck in mourning the loss of past sites for our summer Walks. Still others in the Emmaus community regarded this event as God's providential guidance to become involved with other churches, thus increasing the breadth of the Emmaus mission. Certainly, God has granted us a time for reflection regarding the summer Walks.

Second, we could view this change as a wonderful gift given to our community to energize, unify and move our community on to greater goals, such as increasing the involvement of our community through the process of holding summer Walks at new sites. In fact, this has occurred and continues to build as we move closer to the Walk dates.

Third, perhaps God is granting all of us the opportunity to seek His guidance in the transition to another Walk site. We learn from the scriptures that God is present in periods of distress and attempts to make His presence known so that we will be strengthened. Could it be that God is seeking to increase our awareness of His presence in this period of transition? Could it be that Jesus is bidding us to, "Come and see?"

Well, all of the above may be considered speculation. Now, let us focus on what we have learned. We have learned that our earnest prayers and dedication to His mission through Emmaus Walks, resulted in God granting our Emmaus community the wisdom, discernment and determination to meet and resolve this challenge. And with this resolution came the strengthening of our faith in God's grace and compassion. So, let us celebrate God's gift of "easy living" in the summertime. Keep the faith.




Directions to Sulphur Grove UMC from Normandy UMC:



SPONSORSHIP TRAINING

Before sponsoring someone for a Walk, you are required to attend the sponsorship training. The sessions are held at 6:30pm before Gathering in Room 214 at Normandy Church. This is a short time of discussion, questions, and answers. Also, from The Emmaus Library, we have the Sponsorship booklet, which guides individuals through the process of sponsoring fellow pilgrims on the Walk to Emmaus. The authors explore the range of possibilities in the role of the sponsor for the renewal of church leaders, Emmaus communities, and the church. The booklet is available at Gatherings, and the cost is \$5. The next session is June 10th.
