The venue will be signed off the Steeple Road between Latchingdon and Maylandsea.

- Timing** : Technical Inspection and Signing-on begins at 8:30am. Machines must be inspected before rider (and passenger) sign on.
Signing-On closes and Practice commences at 09:30am
- Jurisdiction** : Held under the Standing Regulations and Sporting Code plus Classic Rulebook of the Amateur Motor Cycle Association (AMCA). Open to members of the Pre 65 Motocross Club Ltd and all AMCA Classic clubs.
- Entries** : Open Immediately. **No late or on the day entries. CLOSING DATE (received by Secretary): 6 SEPTEMBER 2014.**
Primary entry is for ONE CLASS ONLY. Additional classes requested incur additional charge and are subject to availability as priority will be given to those entering as a primary class.
All entries are to be made on the attached Entry Form only together with the correct total entry fee (see entry form) and a Stamped-Addressed Envelope and received by the Meeting Secretary before the entry closing date stated above.
An individual cheque per entrant is requested (no combined cheques please) to be made payable to the 'Pre 65 Motocross Club Ltd' with the riders number clearly written on the reverse.
- Age Limit** : **No riders (or sidecar passengers) under 18yrs of age.**
- Machine Eligibility** : As per current AMCA Classic rules. All machines must be fitted with an effective silencer and engine cut-out device.
Carburettors fitted must comply with current AMCA Classic Rules for all classes.
- Clothing** : Clothing should comply with current AMCA Classic rules. **The use of tear-off's is not permitted.**
- Licences** : All Riders and Passengers **must** bring their current AMCA Classic Licence to Signing-On.
- Day Licences** ^[1] : Required by any entrant NOT in possession of a current AMCA Classic Licence. Not available at the meeting and must be requested with your entry. **Photo ID must be shown when Signing-On.** There is a supplementary fee for each day licence required (see entry form). *Please enter the word 'DAY' in the AMCA Licence number field on the entry form.*
- Day Membership** ^[2] : Required by any entrant NOT a current member of an AMCA Classic Club. There is a supplementary fee for each day membership required (see entry form). *Please enter the word 'DAY' in the AMCA Classic Club field on the entry form.*
- Marshals** : Must be aged between 18 and 75 years. Riders are requested to bring a marshal. If there are insufficient volunteers for marshals, there will be a ballot of competitors (Pre65 Motocross Club members only) and those selected will have to marshal for half of the meeting.
- Behaviour** : The Officials of the meeting are all volunteers and they deserve to be treated with respect. Any rider who abuses any Official or ignores their instruction will be excluded from the rest of the meeting and subject to penalties as defined in the AMCA Rulebook. **The riding of any motorcycle, minibike or bicycle in the paddock is not permitted on race day by any person(s) in attendance whether entrant or spectator.** Riders are also responsible for the behaviour of any persons attending with them. Their behaviour may also render the rider liable to such action.

- ^[3] The Clubman Allcomers Class (5) is an entry level class and as such, any rider entering this class may not participate in any other solo Racing class for the event.

A refund will be given for cancellations received by the Meeting or Club Secretary **up until noon of the day before** the event. No refund will however be given for non-attendance on the day of the event or once the rider has signed on.
