**Day 1:** Importance of Teaching about Treaties and the Treaty Relationship in Classrooms & Linkages to Manitoba Education Curriculum Outcomes

**Day 2**: Teacher Hands-on Activities: Integrating Treaty Education into the Classroom & Grade Level Discussions

TARGET AUDIENCE: Priority given to Grades K - 6 teachers who plan on implementing the *Treaties and the Treaty Relationship: Teacher Guides for Kindergarten to Grade 6* in their classrooms over the 2013-2014 school years. The session can accommodate up to 50 teachers (25 Gr. K-2 & 25 Gr.4-6).Please register early.

### Workshop participants will receive:

- Two (2) days of Treaty education training;
- One (1) teacher per school will receive one (1) Treaty Education Kit, free of charge;
  - Kit includes: Teacher Guides, with lesson plans, for Grades K- 6 levels; plus a variety of Treaty education learning resources
- Additional teachers will receive classroom resource materials only;
  - plus any updates which will be added the schools Treaty Education Kit;
- Teachers are encouraged to bring laptop if possible.

Schools that have previously received a Treaty Education Kit are still encouraged to support other teachers by sending them for training as well. The Treaty Education Kit is intended to be shared among teachers within the school and is to be stored in the school library. Future plans include having additional kits available to schools on a cost recovery basis through TRCM. Schools will be notified when this option is available.

A TRCM certificate of completion will be awarded to those who complete the full two-day training event. Resource people will include Elders and TRCM staff.
