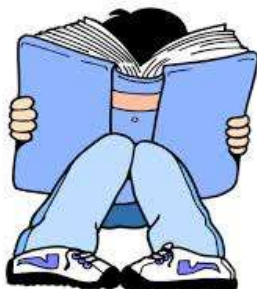


• Reading Log •

As part of daily homework, please read a minimum of twenty minutes every night (Monday-Thursday), and, yes, more is better! When you finish, please write the title of what you've read and the approximate number of pages. At the end of every week (usually on Thursday), parents will sign that you did read nightly. If you do not read on a particular night, please put an "X" in the box and be sure to spend some time reading over the weekend. I will keep track of the students who have read and brought in their signed Reading Log; students who have not missed a week will be rewarded with a special lunch period at the end of each marking quarter.

I hope that you enjoy the process of reading. Please choose a book that is "just right" and that you find interesting. If you need help selecting a book, please ask for help!
