We understand that the individuals volunteering under this agreement will not receive any compensation for the above work and that they will NOT be considered to be Federal employees for any purpose other than tort claims and injury compensation, and we understand that volunteer service is not creditable for leave accrual or any other employee benefits. We also understand that either the National Park Service, or we, may cancel this agreement at any time by notifying the other party. We agree to provide the National Park Service with a listing of active participants, and the number of hours each contributed, when and as requested.
