The *Utah Food Services Culinary Scholarship* is available to full-time students who are passionate about preparing and cooking food, who wish to make culinary arts a career. This \$5,000 scholarship may be used for tuition, books, supplies and fees, and may be used in combination with other forms of financial aid.

This scholarship is open to continuing full-time Culinary Arts students with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5. In selection a recipient, passion for preparing and cooking food will be given greater consideration than high GPA.

Basic requirements:

- Must be a continuing, full-time Culinary Arts student
- Submit a copy of most your recent SLCC transcript showing a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5
- Submit a 1-2 page typed personal statement describing the reasons you chose Culinary Arts as a career, and your goals for the future.
- Submit two letters of recommendation from Culinary Arts faculty members addressing your work habits, career potential and level of passion for preparing and cooking food.

Application Deadline: July 1, 2013. Applications received after the deadline cannot be considered. Applications can be submitted to the SLCC Financial Aid Office at Redwood Campus, South Campus or Jordan Campus, or mailed to the Financial Aid Office at the address above.
