Important information

When submitting your application, **you must include the following documents:**

- Officially certified copies of your original graduation diploma from upper secondary school
- Officially certified copies of a transcript of grades and courses (if they are in different document than the diploma) from upper secondary school
- Officially certified copies of a translation of your leaving certificate from your upper secondary school (with the exception of certificates written in English, German, French or any of the Nordic languages)
- Certificate of English proficiency equivalent to such tests as TOEFL (500/173 points), or University of Cambridge/Oxford or sufficient length and level of studies in the English language in your upper secondary school.
- Transcripts of previous university studies, if any, must be sent directly from the university to Göteborg University.

All certificates must be issued by the the official educational authorities of your country, or the equivalent. Applications with incomplete documents will not be considered.
