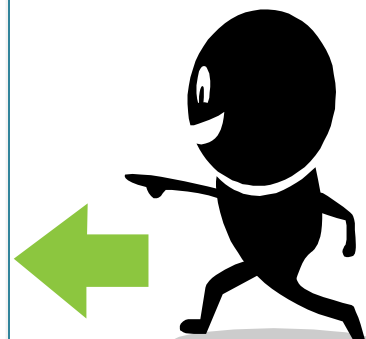

## SUPPLIES:

## GRADES:

HOMEWORK: Will be given usually between 4-5 times per week.

QUIZZES: Some may be announced others may be spontaneously given throughout the course of the year. These quizzes are an indicator to see who has been listening, reading, and studying. In short, always be prepared!

EXAMS: Will be given every week. These exams are designed to show how well you have mastered the material. The best way to score well on these exams is to *consistently do your homework* and to *frequently review and study your notes*.

STUDENT PORTFOLIOS: These portfolios will contain all of your work such as, homework, quizzes, and exams. All portfolios should be neat and up to date.

### Grade Break-Down

Exams: 60% of your grade (exams and quizzes)

Participation: 20% (homework, portfolios, classroom participation, attendance)

Classwork: 20% (all assignments worked on in class)
