Application Requirements:

- 1. Completed Casual Academic Application Form
- 2. Updated CV
- 3. Copy of Qualifications and/or academic transcript
- **4.** Two references or the details of two referees
- **5.** A copy of visa for non-Citizen or PR

Note: New applicants should submit all requirements (1-5) while those who have been a casual academic last year should just submit number 1.
