Registration booth located at St. Louis Royal Canadian Legion parking lot. Registration materials will be available for pick up at the official registration booth. No vehicles permitted to participate without a registration number. Cars/motorcycles trailered may be dropped off for the event and trailers may be stored at the site of the former Riverside Arena (approx. 6 blocks east). All vehicles must be properly licensed in their own province or state.

OPERATION:

Olde Riverside Town Centre and the City of Windsor reserve the right to restrict entrants to acceptable behavior during any and all events and activities of the Car Show. Open headers and unnecessary tire-spin, or any other reason an entrant or vehicle, appearance or conduct are deemed objectionable by event management, entrant and his/her car/motorcycle will be subject to eviction from the premises.
