WHAT:

The purpose of this ministry is to learn about Communion in the Episcopal Church, organize and hand out seashells for the 9:00 a.m. worship service, and provide a God and Me (1st -3rd) Grade and a God and Family Class (4th and 5th Grade)_for Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts and other interested children that attend St. David's Episcopal Church

Using the God and Me and God and Family Workbooks children will participate in memorizing and learning about various parts of the bible. Hands on activities will be used.

For the Communion Class we use the book This Bread and This Cup written by Mary Lee Wile. The class includes sharing a meal, gospel stories, what we use during Eucharist and an instructed Eucharist with the Priest.
