I will continue our discussion of the church being God's gift to the world this week with a message entitled *Church of Thieves*. I hope to see you there!

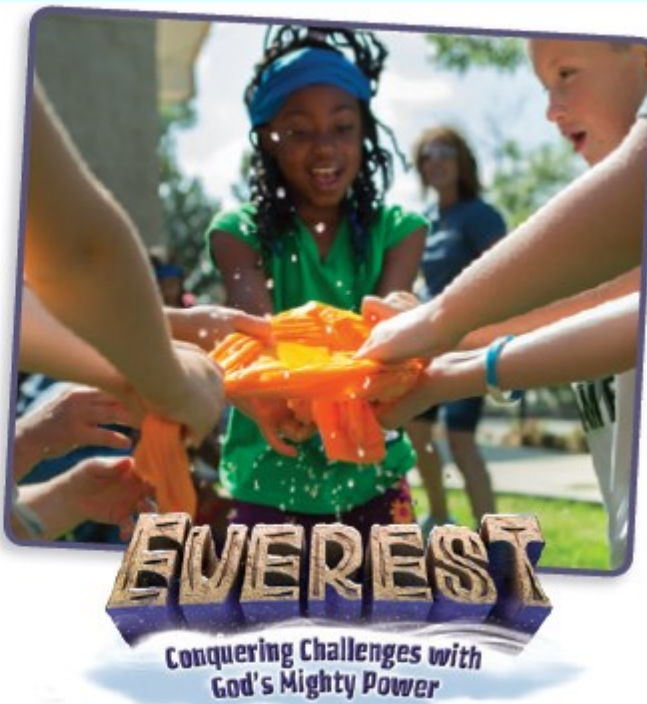
