



Sharing Sacred Places

Travel information

By road

There are a couple of car parks close to Michaelhouse, but they are expensive and often full: it is probably best to use the Park & Ride site on the Maddingley Road in west Cambridge. Approaching Cambridge from the south or west, go to Junction 13 on the M11 and drive a short distance towards the city. The P & R site is on the left, and the bus drops you off in Bridge Street. From there it is 5 minutes' walk to Michaelhouse (see map link below).

Travelling from the north, take the A14: where it joins the start of the M11 keep left: where it divides again keep right following signs to Cambridge city centre, which will lead you along the Huntingdon Road. After 2 miles, at traffic lights at the bottom of the only short hill (Castle Hill), turn right into Northampton Street and right again at the mini-roundabout leading into the Maddingley Road. The P & R site is about a mile along on the right.

Travelling from the east, take the A14, leave it at junction 32, and follow the road to the city centre. At the 5-way traffic light junction (with a hand car-wash operation on your right) turn right then after 20 yards turn left. This will also bring you down Castle Hill: follow directions as above.

By train

There are fast trains every 30 minutes from Kings Cross, and usually two trains an hour from Norwich, with hourly trains from Kings Lynn.

A regular bus service runs from Cambridge station to the city centre: Michaelhouse is 10 minutes' walk from the bus stop. See map link below.
