Who is Eligible?

Any Year 12 student currently attending Newman Senior High School, who is accepted into a TAFE course of study for 2015.

What is it?

A grant of \$10,000 per annum will be made available to one successful Year 12 applicant towards the cost of TAFE education. This will be in the form of two payments of \$5000 to the student at the commencement of each semester of study.

The Semester 2 and following year payments are conditional on producing evidence of satisfactory progress and enrolment for second semester.

What is the selection process?

A selection panel of the current principal of Newman Senior High School and another staff representative will assess all applications. One student will be chosen to receive the grant based on academic excellence and potential to succeed in a TAFE course of study. The committee reserves the right to make no award if in their view there is no suitable applicant.
