Before applying to the Radiography Program, students must complete the following:

- Apply, and become accepted to Riverland Community College. (Contact Admissions 1-800-247-5039/507-433-0600.)
- o Fall 2013 Applicants must have completed CHEM 1101 Introductory Chemistry, or currently be registered in this course by the spring 2013 semester. Students may be enrolled in the following pre-requisites when applying: BUSO1668 Medical Terminology, BI OL2021 Human Anatomy & Physiology I (must be within the past 5 years of the semester you begin Radiography classes). Prerequisite courses need to be completed with a letter grade of C or higher prior to Fall Semester 2013. Complete the table below with the requested information.
- Due to limited enrollment, **applications will only be accepted January 1-February 25, 2013** for consideration for the 2013 Fall Semester. Students will be notified by letter of their status following the review in early March. Applications will not be accepted if **postmarked after February 26, 2013** or if the application is incomplete.

I have included proof of successful completion of BIOL 2021 A&PI or evidence of enrollment at other colleges and received a grade of a 'C' or higher within the last five years of the semester you begin Radiography classes. (It is not necessary to include proof if completed at Riverland)
I have had official college transcripts sent to Riverland's Registrar's office. (It is not necessary to include RCC transcripts.)
I have had official college transcripts sent to Riverland's Registrar's office as e-transcripts. If you have questions concerning your transcripts, please contact Mary Kay Wilson at 507-433-0660 or marykay.wilson@riverland.edu .
I have included an e-mail address on the application.
Optional: I have submitted ACT scores with application. If not, or have questions, please contact your High School for information ACT scores pertaining to your or contact ACT directly at www.actstudent.org . In order to receive ACT points, a copy of your testing scores MUST accompany the radiography application.

NOTE: Radiography Program CPR Requirement

Radiography students are required to obtain and remain current with CPR certification for Health Professionals throughout their academic career. Proof of certification needs to remain valid through the entire academic year of 8/13 – 8/15. Students must provide a copy of certification before the second semester of the program.

American Heart Health Professional certification is the required standard for allied health and health science programs at Riverland Community College, primarily because this certification typically spans the same two-year period that flows in parallel with the College's related two-year degree programs. Although American Heart certification is the required standard at Riverland, the College recognizes the equivalency of the American Red Cross Professional Rescuer certification.

NOTE: Radiography Program Background and Drug Screening Requirements

Minnesota Statutes, chapter 245C, requires the Minnesota Department of Human Services (DHS) to conduct background studies on individuals providing direct contact services to people receiving services from facilities and agencies licensed by DHS.

The Riverland Community College Radiography Program reserves the right to deny admission to anyone who has been convicted of a crime (misdemeanor or felony) or is pending a criminal charge (excluding minor traffic violations.) It is also understood that conviction of a felony may be grounds for denial of eligibility to complete the ARRT licensure examination.

The Riverland Community College Radiography Program reserves the right to conduct Drug Screening tests prior to admission to the program.

Riverland Community College is asking you to provide private information in order to process your radiography application form. This information will be used for preparation during the radiography application review. You are not legally required to provide this information; however, the college may not be able to effectively process your request if you do not provide sufficient information. Access to this information will be limited to school officials. Under certain circumstances, federal and state laws authorize release of private information without your consent to state and federal agencies or as otherwise permitted by other state and federal laws.
