
## Management and Leadership Academy Series

The program focuses on topics which are faced by teachers and administrators on a daily basis and solutions are offered for dealing successfully with the issue in order to move forward.

**Leadership Academy Series:** The Leadership Academy deals with subjects critical to the survival not only of education but to the educators who administer the process. The class focuses on issues continually highlighted in importance by the Nation's media under the auspices that what education does not create, it must solve. The professionals engaged are prepared to help Michigan's educators deal successfully with their solutions.

**Online Issues in Education Series:** The newest program series identifies important issues at all levels of education. Discussion among students will focus on questions and answers which educators can use to meet the daily challenges faced both in the classroom and at the central office level to prevent mistakes from the past occurring again in the future.
