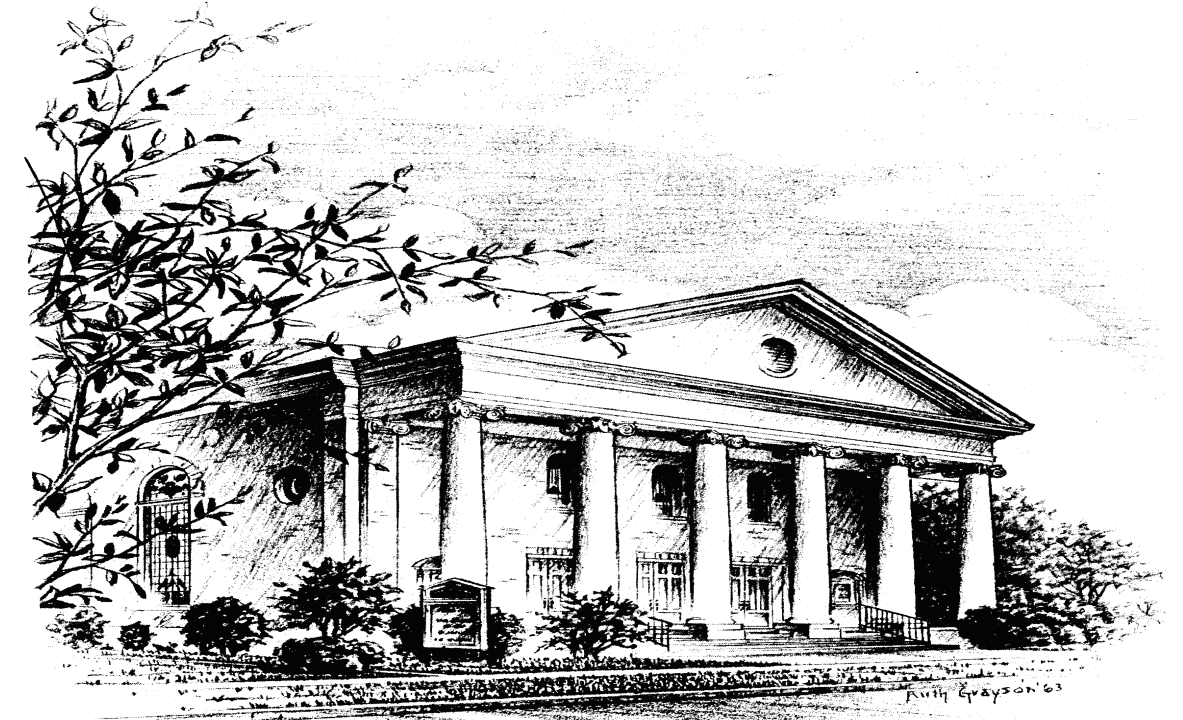
The following items are needed and will be collected weekly in a basket labeled "UMCOR School Kit items" which will be in our Fellowship Hall: round-tipped blunt scissors (metal blades only); 8 1/2 X 11 spiral bound notebooks or top bound pads, 150 page packs of loose leaf paper, hand-held pencil sharpeners (at least 1 inch long), plain hard or flexible centimeter rulers, unsharpened pencils (plain-no designs), 2 1/2 erasers (plain-no designs) and 24 count boxes of crayons.
