Dear Parents,

Y4 Camp – **Thursday 21st May 2015**

Each year, our Year 4 children have the opportunity to spend a night camping in the school grounds. This year's camp has been extended over 2 days and will take place overnight on **Thursday 21st May** in the area outside the hall. The camp is a highlight of the Year 4 calendar and I hope that your child will be able to attend.



The children will need to arrive at school at the normal time on Thursday 21st May. **All children will need to bring a packed lunch on Thursday**, but the following meals will be provided: evening meal on Thursday, breakfast and lunch on Friday. In addition to this we will also keep the children well stocked up with drinks and snacks (including lollies) throughout the camp!

We plan to spend the days and evening separate from the rest of the school, in and around the school grounds, undertaking activities such as pond dipping, art in nature, scavenger hunts and, of course, a camping sing-along. After breakfast on Friday the children will continue to take part in activities. We will provide a packed lunch for all children on the Friday. **Parents may collect their children earlier on Friday 22nd May, at 1.10pm**, if they are concerned that their child may be tired from the sleepover. Please indicate on the attached form whether you intend to collect your child early, or if they will be staying at school until 3.30pm as usual on the Friday.

There will be at least four members of staff on site overnight with at least two awake at any point, including a trained first aider. We organise the tent allocation in single sex groups and aim to ensure that children are with at least one chosen friend. If you are able to provide a tent, we usually allocate your child to that tent but if your child is happy to share another tent with a friend, please indicate this on the form below.

Please return the reply slip and medical form attached by **Tuesday 21st April** if you would like your child to take part in the overnight camp. To cover the cost of meals, we would appreciate a contribution of **£7 per child**. If your child does not wish to take part in the overnight camp, they should still attend school as usual on Thursday and Friday.

Further details will follow once you have booked a place but if you have any queries, please attend a brief **meeting after school on Tuesday 21st April at 3.30pm in class 4T.**
