# 1. Complete BJUP Order Form

# **FAQs**

# Q: Will I be able to have my special needs child tested?

Due to limitations in helpers, we regret that we will NOT be able to make any special concessions for special needs students. If your child can take the test under the same conditions as the other students (including the time limitations), they are welcome to be tested.

# Q: What will the test schedule be? (all times approximate)

#### Grade 3

- Wednesday- Listening tests (9am 10am)
- Thursday (9am 12:30pm)
- Friday- Core Battery (9am 10:30am), Complete Battery (9am 1:30pm)

#### Grades 3-8

- Thursday (9am 12:30pm)
- Friday- Core Battery (9am 10:30am), Complete Battery (9am 1:30pm)

#### Grades 9-12

Friday- Core Battery (9am – 12:30pm), Complete Battery (9am – 3pm)

# Q: Will you test my child if I'm not a member of SHIELD?

No. This is a service to SHIELD members only.

# Q: What is the difference between the Core Battery and the Complete Battery?

The Core Battery consists of the math, reading, and language subtests. The Complete Battery includes all the Core Battery tests (math, reading, and language) as well as sources of information, science, and social studies. These subtests are optional. They will be given on Friday after the core battery is completed.

# Q: Who will be administering the test?

Beth Martin is the Test Coordinator. Beth has a current SC teaching certificate and is a certified tester of the Iowa Test of Basic Skills with Bob Jones University Press. All tests will be ordered from BJUP and returned to them for scoring. There will be one BJU certified tester and one assistant assigned to each testing room.

## Q: Can my child use a calculator?

Students are permitted to use a calculator on some (not all) of the math subtests. A calculator is not necessary to complete the work and it is optional. If your child normally does not use one, I would not recommend them using one for this test. We will not provide calculators. If you want your child to use one, they must bring it themselves.

## Q: Will my child only be tested with other children of the same grade?

The high school will be a separate group. The lower grades (3-8) will be divided based upon our numbers. We will try to limit class sizes to no more than 15.

### Q: Will my child receive any breaks and snacks?

We will not provide a snack. We recommend that you send a snack with your child to eat during the break. Students may bring water into the testing area, but no other open snacks or drinks will be allowed in the testing room. On Friday, all high school students, and all younger students (grades 3-8) who plan to take the complete battery, need to **bring a lunch** with them.

## Q: Where can I get practice tests for my child?

You may order practice tests from Bob Jones Testing and Evaluation. We do not order or administer practice tests.

### Q: Why can't I send in the order directly to BJU myself?

In order to ensure that proper testing procedures are followed and that testing is adequately staffed, we need to know in advance how many students we will be testing.

## Q: When will I get the results of the test?

The results will be sent directly to you 6-8 weeks (maybe less).
