Qualification Title: Sign Language L2 in Communication Skills

Awarding Body: OCSL (The Open College of Sign Language)

Course Length: 30 weeks (3 hrs per week)

Entry requirements: Completion of a Level 1 Foundation Course such as OCSL or CACDP, or some previous knowledge/experience.

Practical skills:

Students will be required to show that they can understand and respond to everyday general conversation in the Deaf Community in an acceptably fluent manner. Assessment is by 20 – 25 minutes of signed conversation.

- 1. Deaf Community & Culture**
- 2. Facilities in your Area**
- 3. Domestic Arrangements**
- 4. Deafness**
- 5. Sign Language – Why Learn?**
