Qualification Title: Sign Language L2 in Communication Skills

**Awarding Body**: OCSL (The Open College of Sign Language)

Course Length: 30 weeks (3 hrs per week)

**Entry requirements**: Completion of a Level 1 Foundation Course such as

OCSL or CACDP, or some previous

knowledge/experience.

### **Practical skills:**

Students will be required to show that they can understand and respond to everyday general conversation in the Deaf Community in an acceptably fluent manner. Assessment is by 20 – 25 minutes of signed conversation.

The course will cover 5 units (for more information on content, please consult your Sign Language Tutor):

- 1. Deaf Community & Culture
- 2. Facilities in your Area
- 3. Domestic Arrangements
- 4. Deafness
- 5. Sign Language Why Learn?

### Who should do this course?......

Anyone wanting to develop their ability to communicate with deaf people in a work environment; anyone with a deaf relative, friend or neighbour; anyone with the view to interpret or teach; anyone wanting to learn from an interest point of view.
