New Zealand & Australia

Cairns

During Australia's 'winter' this city experiences temperatures up to 28°C with a summer breeze and almost no humidity. This dry season is considered the best time to travel to the area; bring your swim suit and sun protection.

Outback

This desert climate will bring extremes during July. When the sun is out it can reach up to 25°C with bright clear blue skies, but during the night the temperature can fall below 0°C.

New Zealand

As you move South to Auckland, you will experience slightly cooler weather. The temperatures will be warm during the day between 10°C and 20°C, but will fall to around 8°C at night. This weather is perfect for hiking and exploring.
